Sohn Fine Art is proud to present a solo exhibition, "Oceans & Odysseys", featuring oceanic works by world renowned, UK-based artist, Rachael Talibart. Exploring the turbulence and grace of the sea, Rachael Talibart's exhibition will feature serene and inquisitive seascapes as well as works from her popular "Sirens" series. As a child, Talibart spent a great deal of time on her father's sailboat exploring the coastlines of France and the Netherlands. "I spent ages staring at the waves and used to imagine creatures in the sea," says Talibart in an article from Wired Magazine. This left her with a life-long fascination for the ocean in all of its forms. Talibart admits that she is both frightened and fascinated by the sea. Her Sirens series embodies hidden figures that seem to emerge from the water. Inspired by Homer's Odyssey, Talibart gives each image in this body of work the name of a mythological god or goddess. A fast 1/1000 of a second shutter speed and a reduced colour palette allows Talibart to capture the waves in a sculptural form. In an article from Colossal, Talibart reflects on her relationship with the sea, "It makes small, unimportant things of us all yet, at the same time, it is exhilarating and profoundly life affirming."

Outdoor Photography Magazine called Rachael Talibart "one of the best outdoor photographers working in the UK today", and a "landscape master" in 2016. In 2016, she also received the Landscape Photographer of the Year Award in the Sunday Times Magazine. Many accolades followed suit, including winning Black and White Photographer of the Year 2018. Her photographs have been published in books and in print and online magazines. They have been exhibited widely in the UK as well as the US and appear in private collections all over the world.

About Rachael Talibart

Rachael grew up on the south coast of England. Her first career was as a solicitor in the City of London. During the City years, Rachael's friends and colleagues were used to seeing her return from trips with bags full of exposed film; the developing sometimes cost more than the trip! In 2008, she converted to digital and says that is when the obsession really set in. In 2000, Rachael left her City career and, after obtaining two more degrees, she now works full-time on her photography.

Much of Rachael's early childhood was spent at sea. This has left her with a life-long fascination for the ocean in all its forms, but especially in stormy weather. Rachael travels widely for her photographs but retains a special fondness for the South of England where she creates many of her images. For Rachael, nothing beats a day on an empty shore, the wilder the weather the better, and this is reflected in her work.

Rachael's photographs have been published in books and both print and online magazines, have been exhibited widely in the UK as well as Barcelona and the US, and appear in private collections in the UK and USA. She is owner of f11 Workshops, providing photography workshops in the South of England and runs residential photography workshops for the international, fine art photography business, Ocean Capture. Rachael is in demand as a public speaker and writes for photography magazines.
